Our kitchen area is getting a make-over this month. We are opening our Pizza Shop!! Dramatic play is such an important part of learning and I love watching the children explore.

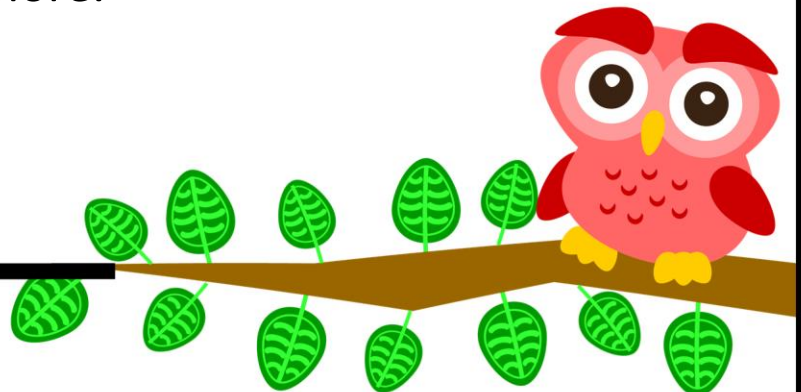
November Birthdays
